Installing CybraryN™ Server as a Service

Issue

In order to have CybraryN™ software connect to your CybraryN™ Server software, CybraryN™ Server must first be installed as a service on the machine it is installed on.

Solution

1. Before you can install your CybraryN™ Server software as a service, you will need to make sure the following file: **NTSVC.ocx** is located in the local Windows or WINNT folder in the System32 directory. If you do not have this file, please contact us at 631-724-5000.
2. Log onto Windows as the Administrator
3. Select **Start > Run**.
4. Enter **regsvr32.exe ntsvc.ocx** and select **Run**. This will register the .ocx file with Windows®. You should see a message letting you know that the file was registered successfully. Select **OK**.
5. Select **Start > Run** and browse to your **cybraryserverzac.exe** file. This is located in your CybraryN™ Server Installation directory.
6. Add **-install** to the end of the line. The final line should appear as:
c:\cybraryserver\cybraryserverzac.exe -install. The installation should come back letting you know that the service was successfully installed.
7. Once the service has been installed, it must be started. If you are using Windows 2000/XP, go to **Start > Settings > Control Panel > Administrative Tools > Services**. If you are using Windows NT 4, double click the services icon.
8. Locate the service called **CybraryN™ Server** and double click on it to start this service.
9. Your CybraryN™ Server software should now be running as a service, which will be visible in the system tray of your server.
